I hereby request a water truck permit from the Town of Amherst. I may be considered:

- A. A contractor (including contractors for government agencies) or any individual wishing to fill a swimming pool or any other noncommercial use; one day permit and \$25/day fee.
- B. An individual or resident not connected to the Town of Amherst water system; 10,000 gallons per month limit and \$25/month fee.
- C. An operator of a government –owned vehicle: one day permit and fee waived

I understand that a Town of Amherst water plant operator must be present during the water withdrawal and that adequate measures must be in place to prevent contamination of the Town's water treatment and distribution system from the applicant's equipment. I understand that this permit shall be automatically revoked if the Town Council of the Town of Amherst imposes any drought-related restrictions on the use of the water processed by the Town for other than normal household use. I have read this information agree to follow all instructions issued by the Town of Amherst's water plant operators who may specify withdrawal locations and methods and are authorized to schedule the withdrawal at their sole convenience.
